

## District Services Board surplus to be returned to municipalities

ESPANOLA—Municipalities within the Manitoulin Sudbury District Services Board (DSB) will be getting money back from its 2012 financial surplus.

Fern Dominelli, CAO of the DSB, told the Recorder after a board meeting, “our finance committee had considered what the surplus should go to and recommended to the board that the 2012 surplus should be returned to the municipalities.”

Mr. Dominelli explained, “the 2012 surplus is \$215,902, and basically what was recommended by the committee and accepted by the DSB board is that these funds will go back to the municipalities based on the 2012 apportionments they had paid to the DSB budget.”
