Note from Acting Interim CAO:

We have recieved a funding letter from MCYS (attached) which confirms our 2010-11 and 2011-12 ongoing funding in relation to Best Start. You will see from the chart below that we will see a reduction in 100% provincial subsidy of \$273,258 for the 2010-11 and an ongoing annualized reduction of \$381,360 effective 2011-12. Based on this information we have determined that there will no negative impact on families or children. Also we feel confident that we will be able to manage any issues that arise with Child Care providers within these allocation. We can accommodate this loss as the present demand for child care is less than the original allocation so the cut could be absorbed.

RE: Child Care – One-Time Investment of \$18 Million in 2010-11

In order to support your Council in planning for the upcoming fiscal year and further to Minister Matthews' letter of May 12, 2009 and the subsequent announcement by the Premier, this memo provides you with details on your notional portion of the one-time provincial investment of \$18 million to stabilize child care as a result of a \$63.5 million shortfall in federal funding beginning in 2010-11.

This provincial investment is intended to help municipalities plan and maintain child care spaces throughout the 2009-10 school year, providing stability for families. It also provides continuity in municipal funding (into the first quarter of the next provincial fiscal year) as the Minister continues to engage the federal government to reinstate its investments in early learning and child care and find long-term solutions to this funding shortfall.

As a result of the federal funding shortfall, your municipality would lose \$381,360 on an ongoing basis from your Early Learning and Child Development Operating Grant. However, the one-time provincial investment of \$18 million reduces the amount of funding at risk in 2010-11 by providing continuity in Early Learning and Child Development Grant funding through the 2009-10 school year. Based on your share of the \$18 million investment, your notional one-time allocation for the second municipal quarter of 2010 (April to June) is \$108,102 (subject to legislative approval).
