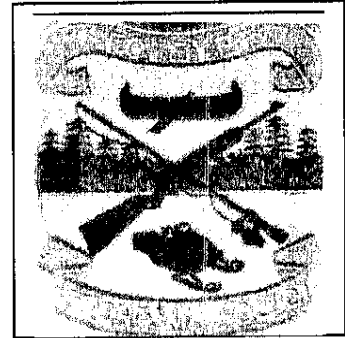

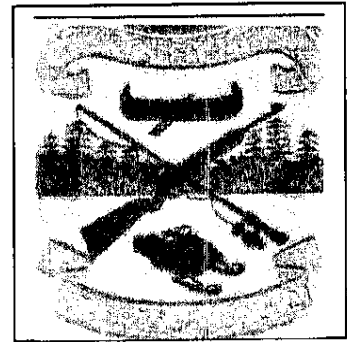

Santa Claus will be in attendance and handing out one small gift to each Foleyet child, free refreshments, and 'goodie-bags' to the Children of Foleyet at the Town Hall.</p> <p>To help defray the cost of this event, we are humbly asking for a donation in the amount of your choosing from the few businesses and organizations operating in Foleyet and immediate area.</p> <p>As the Board may well be aware, there are very few Foleyet-based businesses which we may canvass, and the population of Foleyet is comprised primarily of Old-Age or CPP pensioners, ODSP and Workfare recipients, and under-employed seasonal workers. The children of Foleyet receive very little benefit from the monies your Board budgets for Children's Services, as everything offered for children in this north-eastern district are based in Chapleau. Rarely, perhaps once a year, do we see a program from the workers in Chapleau being offered in Foleyet for our children. A Christmas Parade donation from your board would serve to partially compensate for this inequity, and would be greatly appreciated by the Foleyet Sportsman Club and the children of Foleyet.</p> <p>We are also inviting businesses, individuals and other Foleyet-based institutions to enter floats in the parade.
