RE: 2009/10 First Nations and TWOMO Funding

This letter is a follow-up to the Honourable Minister David Caplan's recent correspondence to Mr. Ray Chenier, Chair announcing your planned funding increase for 2009/10 to provide land ambulance services to First Nations communities and territories without municipal organization (TWOMO). First Nations and TWOMO funding has an inverse effect upon the 50% cost-shared amount. The funding details are as follows:

•	Annualized base funding increase for First Nations of up to:	\$208,580
•	Annualized base funding increase for TWOMO of up to:	\$122,580
•	Annualized 50:50 base funding adjustment of up to:	(\$165,580)
	Net funding (schedule attached):	\$165,580

Your funding will be adjusted in your electronic transfer.

The year-end reporting process will be limited to the recovery of funds relating to under spending and the collecting of performance and accountability information.
