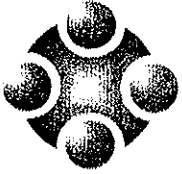

"WHEREAS the Ministry of Children and Youth Services (MCYS) has announced Child Care Stabilization funding for Child Care Providers in order to ensure their viability during the implementation of the Early Learning Program; and

WHEREAS the Sault Ste. Marie DSSAB has been allocated \$102,700 in Child Care Stabilization Funding; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of Children and Youth Services has only allocated \$14,200 of the entire \$102,700 for capital funding; and

WHEREAS Child Care Providers have requested funding assistance to create new infant and toddlers spaces which will require capital improvements to meet the licensing requirements of the Day Nurseries Act;

BE IT RESOLVED that a letter be forwarded to the Honourable Laurel Broten, Minister of Children and Youth Services, requesting that District Social Services Administration Boards and Consolidated Municipal Service Managers be given the flexibility to use the Child Care Stabilization funding in a manner that best suits the local needs of their Child Care Providers."
