Re: Service Manager Federal Funding for Social Housing – 2013 to 2017

As stated in the *Housing Services Act 2011*, (HSA), the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing is required to publish a notice in *The Ontario Gazette* of the annual amount of federal funding payable to each Service Manager.

The ministry has determined the annual allocations for 2013-2017 for each Service Manager and will publish the amounts in the April 28, 2012 issue of *The Ontario Gazette*.

Federal social housing funding allocations for 2013-2017 are calculated based on the same formula as in previous years. This formula includes fixed per-project funding (targeted funding) based on the costs of individual social housing projects transferred to each Service Manager at the time of transfer. In years where there are additional resources in the ministry's Social Housing Agreement allocation, the remaining dollars (untargeted funding) are distributed to all Service Managers based on their proportionate share of targeted funding.

The targeted federal funding for 2013-2017 reflects:

- The same level of federal funding for individual projects as in the 2008-2012 period;
- Removal of funding for projects that have had mortgages/debentures mature or operating agreements terminated; and
- The same level of federal funding for public housing capital for individual projects as in the 2008-2012 period.

In each year of the 2013-2017 period, untargeted federal funding is available and will be distributed proportionately among all Service Managers based on their share of funding in each year of the 2013-2017 period.

It is possible that a Service Manager's federal funding allocation could increase within the 2013-2017 period. This will occur when the value of the untargeted federal funding exceeds the value of projects where mortgages/debentures have matured or operating agreements have expired.

The federal funding is being provided as block funding to offset the costs of social housing. As a result, Service Managers will not see funding amounts allocated to specific programs.

However, consistent with previous ministry practice, Appendix 1 provides a breakdown of the 2013-2017 funding level by social housing program. This will clarify the ministry's allocation and support Service Manager social housing administration. Appendix 2 is a list of projects which have mortgage/debentures that are maturing or operating agreements that are expiring and their related federal funding.

Federal funding is paid to each Service Manager in four equal instalments on the first business day after January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1 of each year. Instalments provided to the Service Manager are the published Ontario Gazette amount less the reimbursement for the Ontario Housing Corporation debenture costs of public housing.

As you are well aware, federal funding for social housing is decreasing over time and funding allocations for 2013-2017 reflect that reduction. Ontario needs a long-term commitment from the federal government that is fair to Ontarians and will help meet the needs of Ontario families. We encourage our housing partners and stakeholders to work with us to secure a long-term federal funding commitment.
