

The Ministry has also reviewed the Manitoulin-Sudbury District Services Board's business case for minor home repairs that was submitted with the Investment Plan and

has no concerns with the proposed approach. Please ensure that the minor home repairs are captured in the Year-End Performance Indicator report.

Service Managers are required to report on the financial section of their Investment Plans three times throughout the fiscal year:

- Mid-Year Update Due by October 31, 2014
- Quarter 3 Update Due by January 31, 2015
- Year-End Report Due by May 31, 2015

Reports are to include the Service Manager's progress against their annual funding allocation and any changes to their projected use of CHPI funding under the selected service categories.

Please note that the Annual Year-End Report for the performance indicator section of the Investment Plan is also due by May 31, 2015.

The Ministry will review Service Managers' Mid-Year and Quarter 3 updates to their Investment Plans to determine if there is likely to be unspent funds in a Service Manager area. The Ministry reserves the right to re-allocate any unspent funds in instances where a Service Manager may not be able to fully use their annual allocation within a fiscal year.
