Once it has been signed by both parties (authorized signatories for the organization and Service Canada), it will become the legal Grant Agreement for your project.
Once the signed Agreement is received by Service Canada, the grant amount will be paid to your organization in one single installment at the beginning of the project. Thereafter, we will forward you
