WHEREAS the Regional Municipality of Peel has sent a letter to the Minister of Health and Long Term Care, the Honourable Eric Hoskins entitled Ambulance Communications and Dispatch Services Advocacy; and

WHEREAS the Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB believes a change to the MPDS system will improve accuracy in 911 triaging thus minimizing the number of ambulance calls requiring an emergency response; and

WHEREAS the Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB requests that the Ministry of Health & Long Term Care expedites this necessary change in triaging methodology across the province of Ontario in an effort to improve efficiency well ahead of the MOHLTC indicated timeframe of late 2018.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB supports the institution of the Medical Priority Dispatch System (MPDS); and

FURTHER THAT the Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB share this motion with the Minister of Health, the Honourable Eric Hoskins.
