Agrees as follows:

Motion Specialties to supply and install one (1) new Stannah "260" TSSA Approved Commercial Stairlift under the following terms and conditions:

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STAIRLIFT DETAILS:

- Custom Curved Inside 180° Flat staircase servicing two (2) levels
- 180° bottom start/park position and 90° top stop/park position
- Mounted on the Left Hand side of the staircase when you are at the bottom looking up

SEAT:

- *i* Sarum seat with vinyl upholstery
- Constructed with a steel frame and flame retardant upholstery
- Two hinged armrests with soft polyurethane upper surface.
- Swivel chair at the top landing via manual push down lever
- One armrest houses directional controls and on/off rocker switch
- 265 lbs weight capacity
- Retractable safety seatbelt

FOOTREST:

- Cast aluminum alloy construction
- Epoxy powder-coated ABS plastic finish with safety edge
- Pile carpet with latex back
- ¹ Safety pads operate safety switches in direction of travel
- Lever operated folding

RAIL:

- Dual steel tube construction w/ approx. 2" diameter
- Epoxy powder-coated to match carriage
- Legs with base plate screwed to floor and staircase
- Rack-and-pinion mounted on lower tube
- Installed approximately 6" from wall in straight sections.

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CARRIAGE:

- Steel construction
- Epoxy powder coated finish to match rail
- DC powered, 0.26kW motor
- *i* Cushioned start/stop
- 0.12 m/s travel speed (slower around bends)
- Microprocessor control unit
- 2 x 12V 7Ah batteries included
- Maximum operating noise level of 70 dB

OTHER FITTINGS:

- Surface-mounted remote control at top & bottom landings
- Charging unit, wall or floor mounted, 24 VDC two stage unit
- Public Building Package
 - Audio-visual device
 - Key lock call/send controls
 - Foldable component safety switches
 - Operating instructions

SITE CONDITIONS: Responsibilities of Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB

- Illumination of at least 100 lux required at the drive unit, seat assembly, and both landings
- Emergency lighting of at least 2 lux for a minimum of 1 hour at both landings.
- Dedicated 120 Volt / 15 Amp circuit with lockable fuse disconnect installed within visible proximity of both landings
- Intercom system to notify the appropriate personal that an individual requires use of said equipment (This may or may not be required and is determined on a case by case basis)
- Stairlift must be in full view while operating wall mounted call/send controls and use of convex mirror may be required in the stairwell
- Provide building permit(s), fire approval and/or engineering services as per local authorities
- Removal of handrails & modifications of stairwell to satisfy all AHJ.
- *Operating license fee to T.S.S.A., renewable every year by building authorities*
- Two (2) preventative maintenance visits per year as required by T.S.S.A.

- Layout drawings
- Supplementary report
- Application
- Specification sheet
- Wiring diagrams
- Test procedure for redundancy and overspeed brake
- Submission, engineering and inspection

MAINTENANCE:

Appendix B is the CSA codebook outlines the required maintenance schedule by CSA and T.S.S.A under CSAB355-09. A 12 month maintenance contract is included in this proposal.

EXAMINATION:

A no charge pre-inspection of the site is a requirement prior to commencing installation. There is an additional charge if the pre-inspection indicates additional work required prompting an additional inspection.

INSTALLATION:

Trained and licensed employees will perform all installation work of the product specification.

SIGN-OFF:

At the final sign off, the user will be instructed in the proper and safe operation procedures as well as the maintenance requirements and warranty details.

WARRANTY:

- Motion Specialties warranties parts for 24 months
- Stannah warranties motor and gearbox for lifetime (must register the stairlift)

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ACCEPTANCE:

The undersigned agrees to pay, the amount mentioned in said proposal, and according to the terms thereof. This proposal will be valid for a period of sixty (60) days from said date at beginning of proposal.

DELIVERY & INSTALLATION ESTIMATE:

- Engineered stairlift drawing: One (1) week
- Stairlift manufacturing: Four (4) Six (6) weeks
- Stairlift installation: One (1) day
- T.S.S.A. inspection and licensing: One (1) -Two (2) weeks after completed installation

INVOICE SCHEDULE:

- 40% upon signed proposal
- 50% when all equipment is installed at site.
- 10% upon sign off & licensing

PAYMENT TERMS:

- Net 30 days from invoice date
- Any invoices outstanding after sixty (60) days will VOID the warranty
- After-Sales service will be withheld if any invoices outstanding after sixty (60) days
- Motion Specialties reserves the right to deny turn-over of the stairlift until complete payment is received

CANCELLATION CHARGE:

50% of contract once the stairlift has entered production
