Report December 7th and 8th, 2016



On behalf of the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development, I would like to thank you and your staff for meeting with me on December 7th and 8th, I appreciated your responsiveness in completing the site compliance process for your organization.

First I would like to compliment you on the electronic filing system you have implemented over the last year. This tool enabled us to easily navigate through your files in order for us to effectively complete the review. All the staff present was extremely cooperative and helpful in helping us during our stay.

As part of the review, I randomly selected five (5) participant files along with the corresponding employer files, as applicable. I also validated Employment Ontario and Information System data against your paper files.

Based on the site compliance evaluation and file review, I have included my observations and recommendations below. I have also noted a timeline for each recommendation listed. This may require a follow-up visit, if necessary, to ensure that these observations have been remedied.

File Documentation and Service Quality

- No consistency exists between files to determine age of registered participants. In order to avoid registering ineligible participants it is recommended that a consistent approach between all employees be developed to obtain and confirm proof of age on file.
- The late closure of files is also an issue; when a file is complete the service provider should make every effort to close the file accordingly and updates the statistics in SP connect.
- It was noted that three clients were listed as 14 years of age when signed up to the program. The guidelines clearly state that participants must be 15 to 18 years old at time of registration.

Service Co-ordination

It was impossible to review all required per-employment training (60 hours) with the files provided during our visit. Although the Learning center is sub-contracted by Manitoulin-Sudbury District Services Board to deliver 40 hours of the pre-employment training the two organizations have to develop a system to ensure all files related to YJC are appropriately filed within the Manitoulin-Sudbury District Services Board and accessible by the Ministry when required.
