## **PURPOSE**

To ensure the adherence with a sound program of, and compliance with Regulatory requirement for inspections, preventative maintenance, and equipment repair of all patient care handling devices and oxygen/suction adjuncts.

## APPLICATION

Paramedics, Paramedic Superintendents, Senior Managers

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1) Each patient carrying, or oxygen/suction device shall be inspected by Paramedics as part of their start of shift inspections.
- 2) The shift start inspection shall ensure each required item is fully operational, and documentation of compliance shall be submitted in Operative IQ.
- 3) Each patient carrying, or oxygen/suction device shall be subject to an established preventative maintenance (PM) program within the required interval. Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB Paramedic Services has coordinated with each manufacturer to implement a PM interval of 6 months, +/- 1 month.
- 4) The PM program shall only be completed by those personnel manufacturer certified to do so. PM documentation shall minimally include the assigned vehicle identification, device serial number, Service ID number and other specified information.
- 5) Upon completion of an PM inspection, a seal shall be affixed to the device listing the inspection date (year/month).
- 6) Where a device failed to operate in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications, the device will be removed from service until it can be repaired by the manufacturer, or alternatively is decommissioned.
- 7) Preventative Maintenance and repair records shall be maintained by Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB Paramedic Service for a period of 5 years.
