### PURPOSE

To ensure all Patient Care is provided in accordance with established Regulations, Standards, Guidelines and Policies.

### APPLICATION

Paramedics, Paramedic Superintendents

### PROCEDURE

- 1) Every certified Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB Paramedic shall provide patient care in accordance with BLS/ALS standards.
- 2) Quality assurance will be ensured through a collaborative methodology between Professional Standards personnel and Health Science North Centre for Prehospital Care.
- 3) Compliance monitoring shall be managed in an ongoing manner, and necessary remediation will be delivered as deemed necessary.
