The Manitoulin-Sudbury DSB provides subsidies to assist applicants with the costs of activities such as registration fees or equipment required to participate in a particular sport or activity. Activities include but are not limited to swimming, soccer, baseball, tennis, Girl Guides, hockey, library, music, skating, arts &



Informal Child Care is available if you're trying to move off Ontario Works, and

need temporary assistance with your child care costs where licensed child care is not available.



Through this program we can help with the purchase of cribs, beds and layettes. We can also assist with emergency needs such as formula and diapers.
